

Dear contesting candidates and voting members,

As notified earlier, this year election for the Management Board of Noida Golf Course Society is to take place on Saturday, the 19 October 2024 between 09 A.M. to 5 P.M. and the venue of the polling is the BANQUET HALL. With a view to conduct the elections in free, fair and impartial manner and for the sake of convenience and clarity, the following directions are being issued for strict observance by all concerned:

- (1) On the date of election there shall be no canvassing or persuasion to influence the voters to solicit vote within the boundaries of the Golf Course. If at all, it must end at the entrance of the main gate. Any candidate or his agent or well-wisher is found flouting this requirement is liable to suffer disqualification.
- (2) Each contesting candidate shall be entitled to appoint two regular members (including spouse) as his representatives to be present at the time of polling and counting. Only two persons, i.e., the candidate himself and one of his representatives shall be allowed to remain present in the polling Hall. They will take seat at the earmarked place. The second representative may act as a reliever. The contesting candidates and their representatives shall display on their person the Identity Cards issued to them.
- (3) It is well understood that only REGULAR MEMBERS, who have cleared all their dues up to 31 August, 2024 are entitled to vote. Arrangement has been made to clear the dues even on the date of poll. A member who has defaulted in the payment of dues may clear the dues on the spot before becoming eligible to vote.
- (4) It is desirable that members who come to cast their votes should possess SMART CARD issued by NGC or any other ID proof such as Aadhar card, passport, driving license, election card etc.
- (5) Before entering the Banquet Hall, the identity of the member eligible to vote shall be checked.
- (6) Carrying of firearms is strictly prohibited.
- (7) At the reception area of Banquet Hall, one would find four separate desks for issue of ballot papers. A member eligible to vote may approach any one of the desks and after putting his signatures on the list of voters, obtain the ballot



papers of different colours (for different category) – three in number – (one for General category candidates, one for Army category candidates and one for Air Force/Navy category Candidate). Each ballot paper bears the signatures of the Chief Returning Officer on the left side upper corner.

- (8) On entry point of the polling Hall, voting member's left forefinger will be marked by indelible ink.
- (9) Six separate enclosures have been erected where the voter would find ink-pad and the stamp/seal on a table to mark the ballot papers with all secrecy.
- (10) In the case of NINE contesting candidates of GENERAL category, a voter is supposed to mark only up to FOUR candidates of his choice; similarly, he will put ink pad mark on ONE contesting candidate in the category of Army & Air Force/Navy category. In case the voter marks more than the specified number of candidates, his vote is liable to be invalidated.
- (11) The voter shall ensure that he does not put any mark of identification or signatures etc. or deface, in any manner the ballot paper. If it is done, his vote is liable to be cancelled.
- (12) After marking the ballot paper with stamp/seal in the specified columns, the voter will please first fold the ballot paper vertically and then horizontally to avoid overlapping of ink into the box of another candidate.
- (13) Three transparent boxes duly sealed shall be placed on table(s) in the middle of the Hall visible from all the sides. Each box would bear the same colour as that of the ballot paper. The three ballot papers shall be dropped in the specified box so as to match the colour of the box and the ballot paper.
- (14) Soon after the voting, the member will please pass through the exit door and enjoy tea/coffee etc. provided by the Club.
- (15) Those voters who turn up to 5 P.M. (by the watch of the Chief Returning Officer) and are present in the queue at the entry point of the Banquet Hall shall be provided with a Card of their being present at the entry point up to or at 5 P.M. and shall be allowed to vote. For example, if the voter is present in queue at 5 P.M. and has been provided with the card authorizing him to vote shall be allowed to cast his vote, even though his turn to cast the vote comes after 5 P.M. Process of voting shall be over only after the last such voter in queue has been able to cast his vote.
- (16) Counting of votes shall commence soon after the close of the poll.
- (17) After the counting is complete, formal announcement of results will follow and certificates shall be presented to the candidates who have been declared elected.

(18) After counting all the ballot papers and other relevant documents shall be kept in the respective transparent boxes and sealed on the spot and handed over to the Secretary of the Club.

(19) In any and all the matters the decision made by the Chief Returning Officer shall be final and unquestionable.

Though tight security arrangements have been made by the District Administration to facilitate the efficient and proper functioning of the entire election process, whole-hearted co-operation of all the contesting candidates and the voting members is solicited.
